Read Genesis 39: 19-23 and respond to these questions:

1. Why would Joseph want us to remember this part of the story?
2. How did he feel toward his brothers now?
3. How hard would it be to keep your faith in God in this place? ...or your faith in people? in yourself? (Joe must have been feeling mighty low.)
4. How did God signal to Joseph, even in this place, that God was still on Joseph's side?
5. Does God promise to save us from tough times or help us get through them?

Notes for Today's Bible Study

1. Can you remember all the parts of the Joseph story in their correct order?
(suggest they make list of symbols (well, etc.) to represent each part of story)
2. Why did Jacob give Joseph the special coat?
Do you think it was fair of him to single out his one son? .. Or did the other sons misunderstand the gift? How could the conflict been avoided?
3. What personality traits or character did Joseph possess that helped him through all his troubles?
4. What do you think happened to the brothers over the years that changed their hearts?
5. Do you think it is a good idea to TEST someone before forgiving them? How is forgiveness best given?
6. Joseph did not fully discover God's plan for his life until his brothers reappeared and he forgave them.
What does that say about how God works in people's lives???
7. Do you think God has a special plan for you?
How can you discover what that plan is?
